Fat fuels Big C rise

OBESITY has fuelled a 20 per cent jump in womb cancer cases over the past decade, a UK study shows.

More than 1,900 women now die from the disease every year, compared with 1,500 in 2002.

Being severely overweight doubles the risk of developing the illness, partly because excess fat contains hormones that can fuel tumour growth.

Extra weight also makes it difficult for doctors to diagnose the cancer.

Cancer Research UK, which released the figures, expressed alarm at the rise, as cases had remained constant for the previous 25 years.
