AN 80-year-old woman managed to take the controls and miraculously land a small plane after her pilot husband collapsed dying mid-air, police revealed. Helen Collins was forced to take over when husband John, 81, lost consciousness while flying the twin-engine Cessna plane above Sturgeon Bay, Wiscon-

sin, US. Helen - who had "very little" flying experience - radioed for help and a local pilot was scrambled airborne to help talk her down. Sheriff Terry Vogel hailed her a hero, adding: "It was a very difficult situation, but she landed safely." John sadly died later in hospital.
